

MOBILE ELEVATED WORKS PLATFORMS SCISSORS AND BOOM

Introduction:

The programme has been developed for personnel whose responsibilities involve working on Mobile Elevated Platforms

Objectives:

To provide the knowledge and practical operating skills to work safely on various types of machines, on completion of the programme operatives will be able to understand their responsibility under the: Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 and other applicable regulations, company and operator safety codes

Programme Synopsis:

- Pre-operational checks: fluid levels, tyres, wheels, brakes, instruments, horn, lights and flashing beacon, hydraulics, safety devices, steering, battery levels, emergency lowering devices, safety harness, securing point, outriggers (if fitted) etc.
- Operator safety checks: safety harness (before use and correct wearing), securing safety harness to correct anchor point
- Travelling to working area: setting up machine in preparation for work, pre-determining height and locations etc
- Setting up in confined area: using all controls to position machine
- Carry out work tasks
- End of work checks and parking

Attending delegates need to supply their own harnesses, hard hats, hi-vis jackets, waist coats and hard boots. Please ensure they bring their National Insurance numbers with them for certification purposes.
